#### **2023-2024 OVERVIEW**

#### 1. **PROGRAMS**

#### **Academy Program**

Our Academy Program at AFU Pike introduces youth players in the 7 to 12-year-old age groups to a more competitive soccer environment. Our Academy's philosophy is one of learning how to play the most popular sport in the world with creativity, fun, and attacking soccer. Challenging training sessions conducted by the Academy staff are the key ingredient in the personal development of the players. Training activities are devised to help each player improve technically, tactically, physically, and psychologically. Games are played against top metro Atlanta clubs to create the necessary ratio and platform for development.

This program is designed for players ages 7 through 11. Our Academy program offers competition against other Metro Atlanta Soccer Club Academy Teams. Typically, teams will have 10 games and play in 2 tournaments per season (Fall and Spring) **Tryouts are required.**Players are selected for teams based on their overall skill level.

#### **Select Program**

This program is designed for players ages 12-18 and offers the opportunity to play in state, regional and national league structures. Select teams to participate in GPL. The number of games varies depending on the age group and performance. U13 and U14 teams will have both Fall and Spring season, where U15 and older teams typically compete in regular games in the Fall season only. Tryouts are required. Players are selected for teams based on their overall skill level.

#### **Tryouts and Evaluation & Team Placement Process**

Our tryout registration is open, and we want any player interested in playing Academy/ Select, AFU Pike for the 2023-2024 soccer year to register as soon as possible if you haven't already. Please keep in mind that registering does not commit you to anything but does help us plan appropriately. FOR LEGAL PURPOSES, ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE REGISTERED FOR TRYOUTS IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE AND MUST BE REGISTERED BY A LEGAL GUARDIAN. LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST BE PRESENT AT TRYOUTS TO SIGN IN THEIR PLAYER.

At AFU Pike our goal is to provide the best possible development platform for every player. Team placement must align with the overall skill level of the player, where the player can be challenged but also find success within the level of play.

AFU Pike will use ID sessions as well as tryouts to evaluate all players. In addition to tryouts, AFU Pike coach and training staff will collaborate through conversations and conferences to ensure each returning player's seasonal play, previous evaluations, demonstrated skill, demonstrated progress & development, maturity, mentality, and overall body of work throughout the 2022-20223 soccer year is factored into their respective team placement for the 2023-2024 season. Current and former coaches as well as program directors are part of the player evaluations.


# Acceptance letters will be sent via email by Monday following tryouts and have 48 hours to accept to reserve their spot on the team.

# **Player Development Pathway**



#### **Recreational Program:**

This program is designed for players ages 4-18 and offers opportunity to learn and enjoy the beautiful game with family and friends in a fun and energetic atmosphere. Our well-established recreation program is the foundation of our club and the starting point for most of our players.

#### **Appleseeds Program:**

This inter-club program is designed for players ages 3-4 and is designed to teach basic soccer skills and encourage the love of the game. This program is led by volunteer coaches and meets ONLY on Tuesdays or Thursdays for a 30-minute session.

#### **Academy Program:**

This program is designed for players ages 7-11, offers competition against other Metro-Atlanta soccer club academy teams. Our Academy introduces youth players to a more competitive soccer environment.

#### **Select Program:**

This program is designed for players ages 12-18 and offers opportunity to play in state, regional and national league structures.

- AFU Pike makes it a priority to select and retain the finest coaches and trainers in the area.
- All payments made to the team coach and trainers are paid by AFU Pike registration fees.

#### Continuing Education for Coaches and Trainers:

- o AFU Pike continuing education a priority for all AFU Pike coaches and trainers.
- Coaches and Trainers are reimbursed for the cost of Grassroots and USSF coaching courses passed by staff.

## • Player Development Program:

 Supplemental player development programs, offered during the season, including striker clinics, goalkeeper clinics and soon to come, Fun Fridays. (Programs differ based on age and team level)

#### GA Soccer Fees:

 Registration, insurance and other benefits with the Georgia Soccer Association, US Club Soccer and USYSA and USSF.

#### • Referee Fees:

- Fees for referees throughout the season
  - Does not include referee fees for tournaments or friendlies scheduled in addition to season game schedule.

#### • Club Administration Costs:

 Website, On-line registration, office supplies, soccer/field equipment, field usage agreements and staff background checks.

#### Annual Field Maintenance:

Sodding, fertilization, cutting and lining of game and practice fields.

### <u>2023 – 2024 Academy/Select Uniforms</u>

#### **General Information:**

- 2023 2024 is the last year of the current uniform cycle below
- Uniform Kits are <u>NOT</u> included in tuition and will need to be purchased for <u>ALL</u> players.
  - Estimated costs:
    - 2 jerseys, 2 pairs of shorts, 2 pairs of socks, outerwear is approx. \$226 + tax.
  - Atlanta Fire United bags and training shirts are required for all players. (Not to be purchased if you already have one)
- AFU Pike uses MyUniform through Lloyd's Soccer. Which is an invitation-based ordering system.
  - Once jersey numbers have been assigned and a club representative enters your information into the site, you will receive an email invitation with instructions to access your account and place your uniform order.
  - The ordering process will guide families through required items and optional items depending on their player's team and level of play.
- Game jerseys are customized pieces with the AFU Pike logo and player number. Once a jersey is customized, it cannot be returned to Lloyd's Soccer.
- All uniforms need to be ordered by June 30th.
- AFU Pike, U9 Bridge will order uniforms from squadlocker.com.

#### Jersey Number Assignment/Selection Process:

- o Duplicate jersey numbers are not allowed within an age group/pool.
- Jersey numbers for the 2023 2024 season will be assigned as follows:
  - <u>Existing</u> AFU Pike players will retain their previously assigned jersey number.
  - New AFU Pike players will be assigned a jersey number by the Directors.
- In the event a player moves to a team with a duplicate jersey number, the moving player will be required to change jersey numbers. A jersey number will be assigned by the Directors.
